Creativity & Planning	Artwork is created with a sketch and plan; student always checks in with the teacher and makes changes that the teacher suggests. Student also goes above and beyond the expectation for the finished product.	Artwork is planned but student checks in only sometimes or not at all. They do not make changes that teacher suggests. Work may appear slightly unfinished.	Artwork is created with no plan in mind, no check-ins with the teacher and work is unfinished or rushed.	Artwork is not created at all. Following Directions	Artwork is created following all directions and asking questions when uncertain.	Artwork is created following some of the directions but not asking any questions when uncertain what to do. Craftsmanship & Neatness	Artwork is created that demonstrates their best effort, neatness and is a complete picture.
